Job and assignments

Handling operators perform complex handling, moving or loading operations for products or parts, either manually or with handling gear. They ensure and supervise that gears are appropriate for the loads. They prepare and secure handling areas, sling loads and perform lifting/hoisting. They work on-shore or abroad. They comply with handling procedures strictly and are involved in the guidance of operating cranes. They report on the performed work.

Work environment

Material-handling equipment operators work in team, workshops or onboard. They liaise with and respond to operational staff. They also closely liaise with technicians, technical assistants and logisticians.
